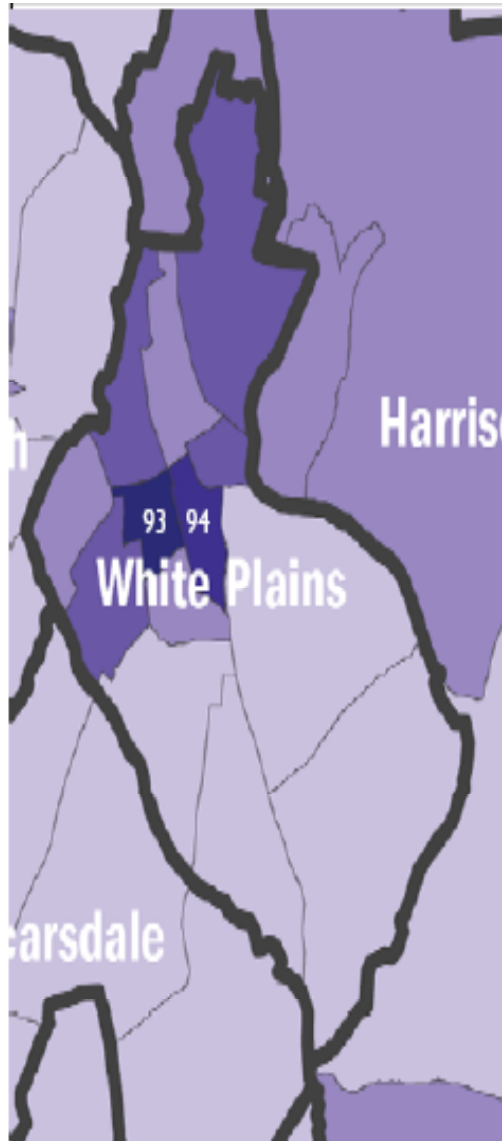

Poverty Rate

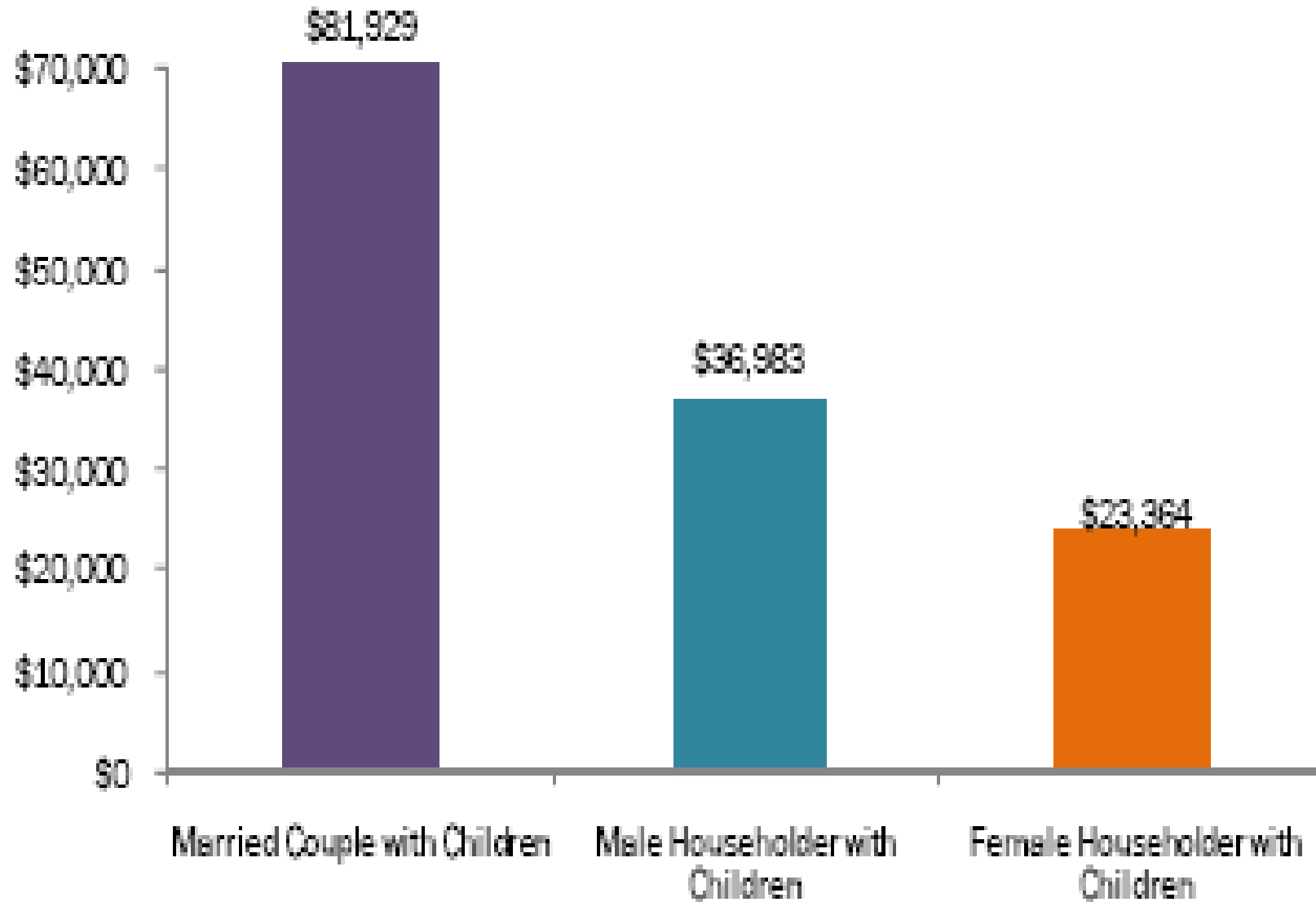


The Poverty rate for White Plains neighborhoods ranges from 0% to 40.87%.

School Population (2004-2005)

- 6,901 children were enrolled
- 12% Limited English Proficiency (LEP)
- 13% below the Census Poverty Index
- 48% received free or reduced lunch
- 2.7% dropped out of school
- 78% graduated after four years of high school

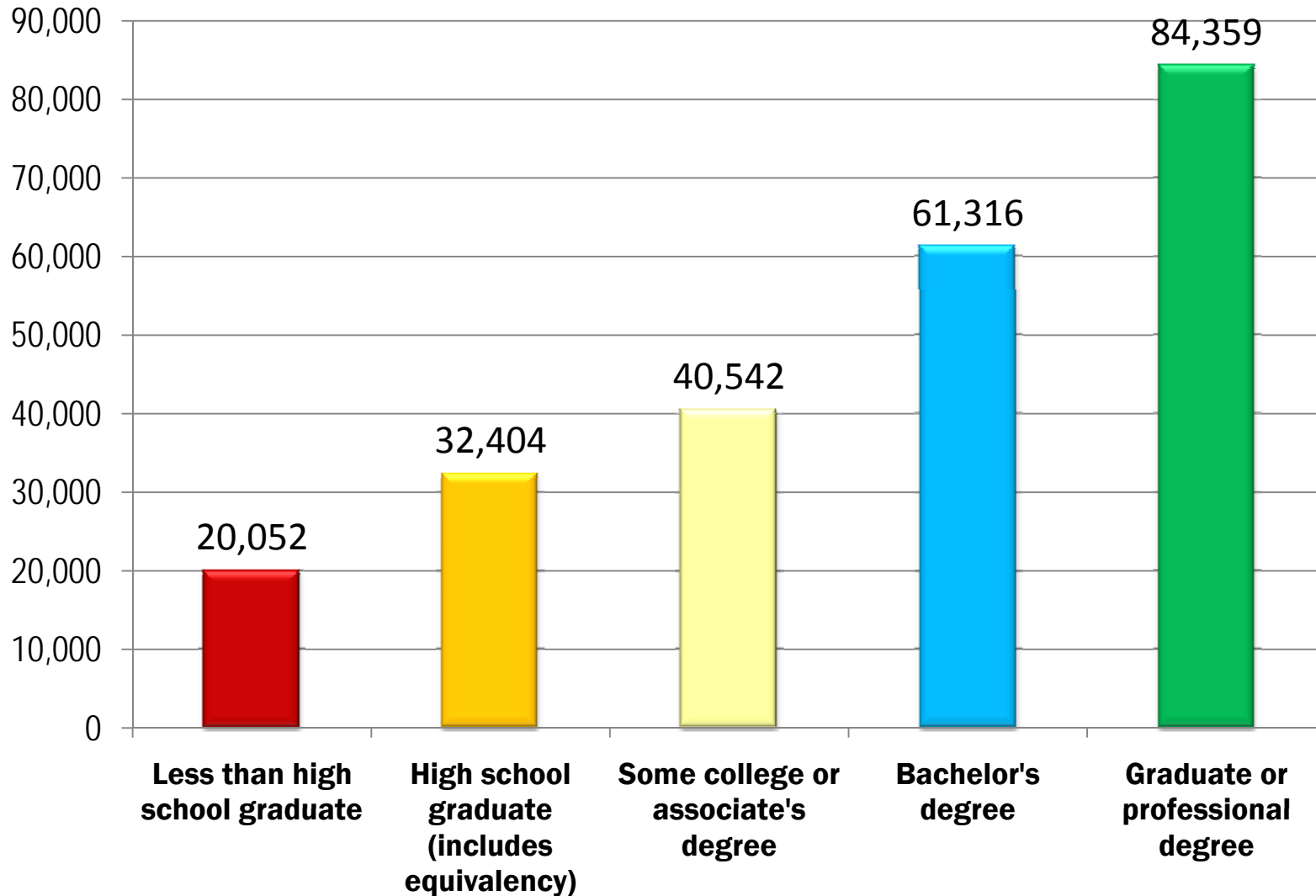

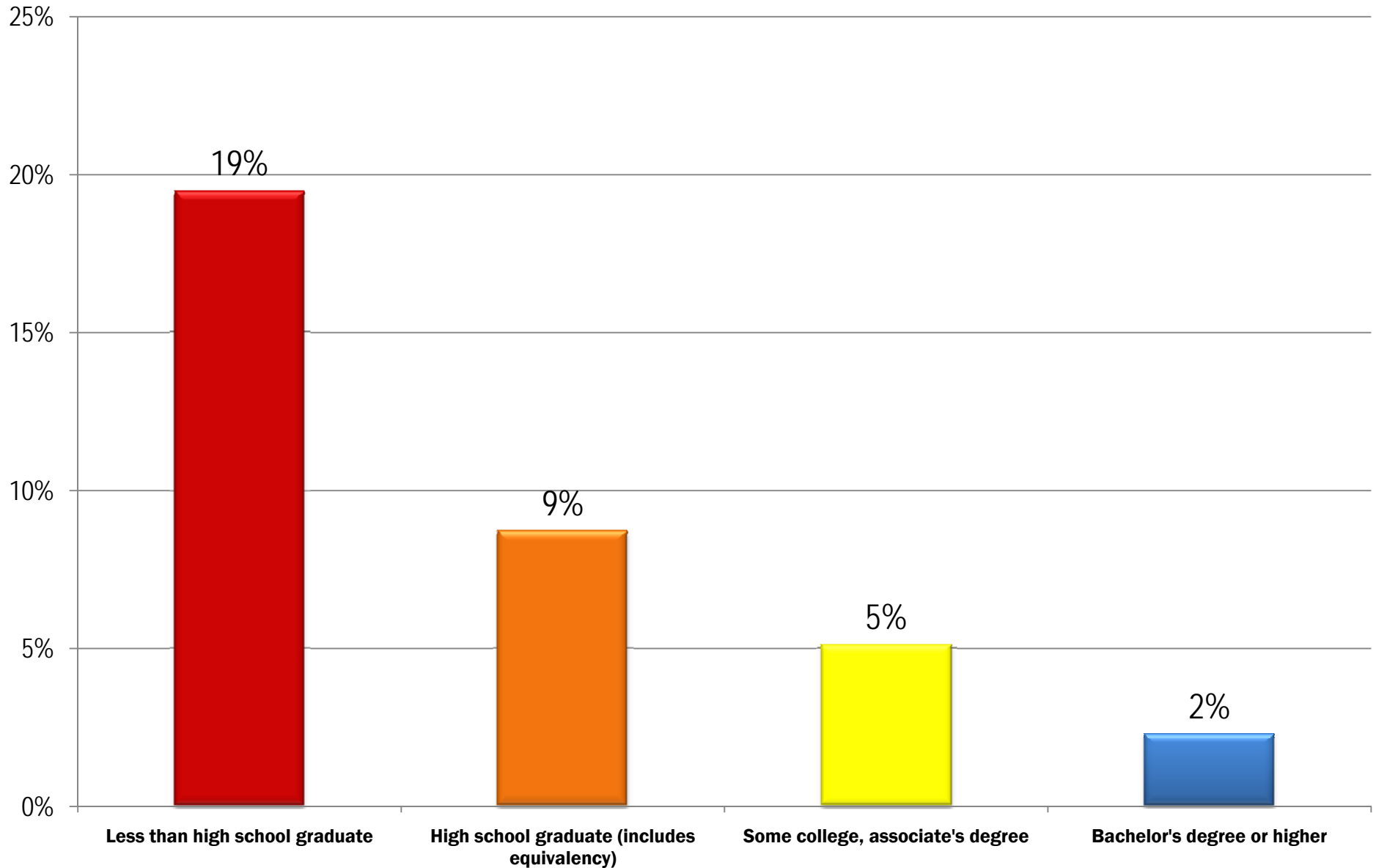
Median Income - Education Level
