<p>Presidential Primary * Tuesday 19 April 2016 <i>New registration with a party affiliation no later than 25 March</i> <i>Absentee ballot</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Ballot request by mail no later than 12 April; in person no later than 18 April</i> • <i>Completed ballot returned by mail no later than 18 April; in person no later than 19 April</i> <p><i>Change of Address no later than 30 March</i></p>
<p>Congressional Primary * Tuesday 28 June 2016 <i>New registration with a party affiliation no later than 3 June</i> <i>Absentee ballot</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Ballot request by mail no later than 21 June; in person no later than 27 June</i> • <i>Completed ballot returned by mail no later than 27 June; in person no later than 28 June</i> <p><i>Change of Address no later than 8 June</i></p>
<p>State and Local Primaries * Tuesday 13 September 2016 (subject to change) <i>New registration with a party affiliation no later than 19 August</i> <i>Absentee ballot</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Ballot request by mail no later than 6 September; in person no later than 12 September</i> • <i>Completed ballot returned by mail no later than 12 September; in person no later than 13 September</i> <p><i>Change of Address no later than 24 August</i></p>
<p>General Election Tuesday 8 November 2016 <i>Must be registered to vote no later than 14 October</i> <i>Absentee ballot</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Ballot request by mail no later than 1 November; in person no later than 7 November</i> • <i>Completed ballot returned by mail no later than 7 November; in person no later than 8 November</i> <p><i>Change of Address no later than 19 October</i></p>

*** In New York State the deadline for a *previously registered* voter to declare or change a party affiliation was October 2015. If you are a *registered voter* and did not declare or change party affiliation before 9 October 2015 you are not eligible to vote in the 2016 primaries. New registrants who declare a party affiliation when they register *are eligible* to vote in the 2016 primaries.**
