



Look Who is Doing Great Work in Westchester County!

The Astorino Challenge in Education (A.C.E.) is a way to encourage Westchester's students in grades 6-12 to do their very best in the classroom from the beginning of the school year to the very end. For students to win this challenge they must either earn perfect attendance for the school year OR achieve a final G.P.A. of 3.8, 95% or "A" equivalent, OR show a full grade point, letter, or percentage point improvement from the previous year's final report card. If a student wins this A.C.E. challenge, they receive a free season pass to Playland. The challenge is open to children in Westchester in grades 6-12. The whole purpose of the ACE challenge is to offer a little extra incentive to get our kids to strive to do their very best in the classroom.
