Raise the Age Lobby Day Tuesday, March 8, 2016

The Raise the Age Lobby Day will be an opportunity for youth and the adults that care about them to speak to state lawmakers about raising the age of criminal responsibility from 16 to 18 years in New York. Organizations from all over the state will be traveling to Albany to ask state lawmakers to enact a comprehensive Raise the Age policy as part of the final state budget.

Raise the age legislation was included in Governor Cuomo's Executive Budget *but, we need to ensure* the legislation stays in the budget. One way to do that is by having a strong presence on March 8th in the Capitol.

WCA will be providing a free bus from White Plains to Albany, as well as advocacy training.
